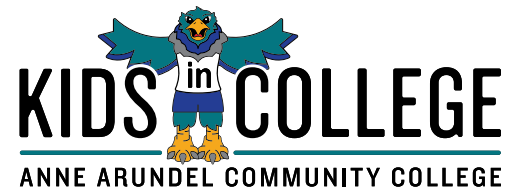

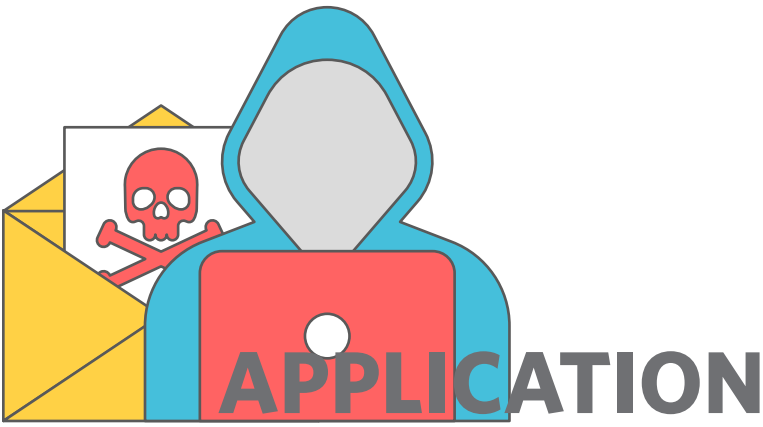

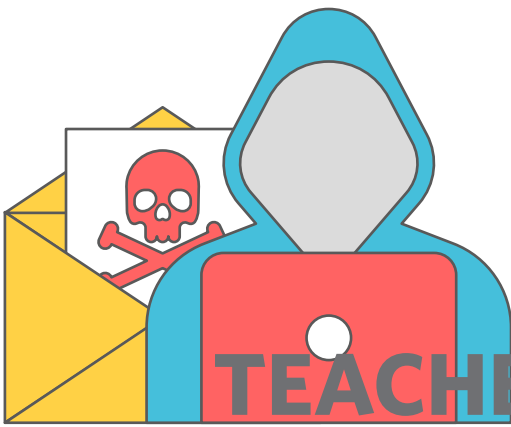

There is no charge for selected applicants. Deadline to submit application is June 2. See back page for information.

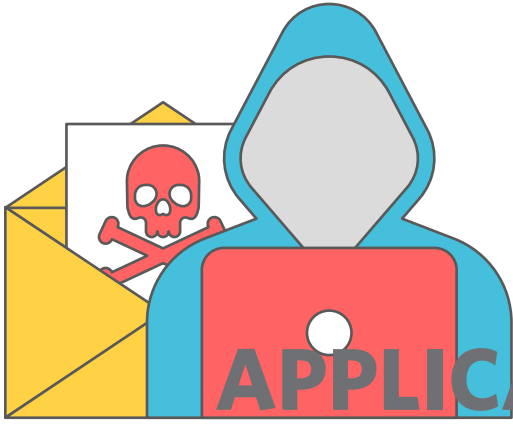
